

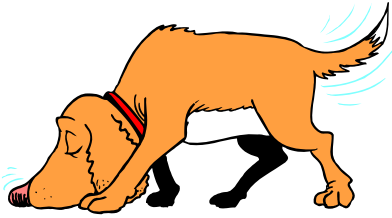

MEETING AUG 12, 2010:

Ten of our members were present to hear Doug Moore of the LdF police department talk about its efforts to start a K-9 patrol by October 1st. He has been with the department about 2 months but was formerly with Menominee County's police department and has 5 years experience using a dog, primarily in drug law enforcement. A dog sniffs and then (if aggressive) scratches or (if passive) stops and stares if drugs are found. They are then rewarded with a ball or rope. They are also used to track humans by scent and search for objects such as a gun. There is only one handler, and the dog lives with him. The dog is considered a sworn police officer. The LdF department already has a fully-equipped canine vehicle and Officer Moore has certification as a handler. Drug activity has increased in the northwoods.

We discussed a change to Minocqua for ArtFair2011, but Laura feels the location is poor even though the rent is less, because of limited equipment being available.

Everyone was encouraged to check out the Minocqua site before the next meeting so we could discuss it. Our annual dinner will be at Marty's on October 14th.
